DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

DECIDE, PAR LES PRESENTES:

Amanda Simon - Appointment as Indian Registration Administrator for Kanesatake

WHEREAS: the Mohawk Council of Kanesatake (MCK) is the legal governing body of Kanesatake and its territory; and,

WHEREAS: a Criminal Records check was effectuated following authorization by Claire Amanda Simon used by the Federal Government of Canada for reliability assessment July 2nd 2009; and,

WHEREAS: Band Council Resolution (BCR) No. 0022.910.00069, dated 5th August 2009 was signed by Chief and Council which stipulates: "THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Mohawk Council of Kanesatake hereby resolves that Claire Amanda Simon be authorized by Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) to perform all secure Certificate Status application processing and distribution duties as of Indian Registration Administrator representing our First Nation."; and,

WHEREAS: Claire Amanda Simon attended an official 3-day training session given by Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) in 2010 and again in 2019 to learn the responsibilities of the IRA who are delegated specific authorities by the Indian Registrar, working at the Band level on behalf of Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) who help band members apply for Indian Status and status cards. According to Section 5 of the Indian Act Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) is responsible for the Indian Register as well as Band Lists maintained by INAC and the IRA is responsible to for applying Protected "A" level of security for all work carried out as an IRA at Band level; and,

WHEREAS: it is understood by the MCK, that the Indian act is a part of an archaic policy that has been deemed contrary to Indigenous rights, including the inherent right to determine our own membership according to our customs and traditions as stated in section 9 of the United Nations declaration on Indigenous rights; and,

WHEREAS: Claire Amanda Simon has maintained and carried out IRA duties since 2009 as Indian Registration Administrator with access to the Indian Registry with her own credentials for write access to the system since 2009; and,
